This position requires concurrent clinical instruction at local clinical sites.</p> <p>The nursing program offers a B.S. in Nursing through pre-licensure and degree-completion options, and an M.S. in Nursing with specializations in Family Nurse Practitioner and Nurse Educator. The program is accredited by the Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education.</p>
