Two or more years clinical healthcare experience (EMT, Paramedic, RN, etc.) or the equivalent combination of education, training and experience.
PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS:	Master's Degree or Doctoral Degree in Healthcare discipline/profession; Licensure or Certification or Registration in the State of Illinois. Three years experience with high fidelity simulation equipment and/or related training equipment. More than two years clinical healthcare experience in medical-surgical, emergency/trauma, or critical care. Teaching experience in academic program, Classroom, laboratory, and/or clinical teaching, in-service experience, preceptor experience, or professional lecturing; Community College experience.
