Participates in University and SON activities. Participates in community outreach activities that promote health. Attends MNSON and University events. Experience in the Emergency Department desired.</p>
<b>PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS:</b>	Minimum of a Master's degree in Nursing for the Instructor rank. An earned doctorate in Nursing (PhD or DNP) or a related field is preferred as well as post-secondary teaching experience.
