Effectively planning and preparing for classes and student success.</li><li>• Delivers learning-centered instruction by establishing a classroom environment conducive to learning and student involvement.</li><li>• Promotes student success in lab and clinical. Provides instruction that will assist students in obtaining skills necessary to meet clinical requirements.</li><li>• Works with students to identify their strengths, learning styles, and areas requiring further development, and to develop and implement remediation plans as needed.</li><li>• Maintain accurate records, submit grades and other reports on time, and enforce College academic and attendance policies.</li><li>• Build student confidence in preparing for the NCLEX</li></ul>

<p><b>MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A Master's degree in nursing from an academic institution accredited by a regional or nationally accredited agency that is recognized by the U.S. Department of Education.</li> <li>• A minimum of 3 years' experience as a registered nurse.</li> <li>• Direct patient care experience within the previous year in a clinical setting or as a clinical nursing instructor.</li> <li>• Current unencumbered Registered Nurse License in Illinois required.</li> <li>• Ability to relate to students and to communicate subject material using innovative approaches and technologies.</li> <li>• Ability to work flexible hours including evenings and weekends</li> <li>• Will be required to teach classroom, lab and clinical component of the assigned course</li> </ul>
