MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:	Master's Degree in Nursing, an active, unencumbered Illinois and Indiana RN license and two years of clinical experience required; teaching experience preferred.
PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS:	Applicants should be familiar with and able to use computer-assisted, multi-media instruction, and innovative teaching techniques in the classroom. Must have excellent oral, written and verbal communication skills; must be comfortable working with a diverse population; and have the ability to make decisions in accordance with policies, rules and regulations.
