| RESPONSIBILITIES: | <p><u>Position Summary:</u></p> <p>The University of St. Francis, a Catholic, Franciscan institution in Joliet, Illinois, invites applications for a full-time Instructor/Assistant Professor of Nursing.</p> <p>Faculty members whose assignments involve classroom and practicum instruction are collectively responsible for curriculum design, planning, implementation and evaluation, and for the development and implementation of specific courses offerings in the curriculum/clinical.</p> <p>The Assistant Professor rank is tenure-track for qualified applicants available in August 2021, and pending budget approval.</p> <p>The College of Nursing offers CCNE accredited undergraduate and graduate programs as well as a Doctor of Nursing Practice degree. We serve traditional aged and adult students through a variety of learning formats.</p> |
