The position may also include graduate-level teaching.</p> <p>The nursing program offer a B.S. in Nursing through pre-licensure and degree-completion programs, and an M.S. in Nursing with specializations in Family Nurse Practitioner, Adult-Gerontology Nurse Practitioner, Adult-Gerontology Clinical Nurse Specialist, and Nurse Educator. The program is accredited by the Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education.</p>
MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:	The successful candidate will have a doctorate, preferably a Ph.D., in nursing science or a closely related area (applicants who are ABD will be considered if their dissertation will be complete by August 1, 2015), have an M.S. in Nursing, be eligible for licensure as a Registered Nurse in Illinois, and have educational and experiential background in child health nursing.
PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS:	Those candidates who have the successful university-level teaching experience and a proven ability to conduct research and secure external funding will be given preference.
