## VII. Old Business

1. LPN 2025 draft report:

The data was collected during LPN renewal process beginning in November 2024 through the end of February 2025. Two separate eblasts were sent to all Illinois LPNs in March 2025 requesting survey participation with an end of participation date of April 14, 2025. The collective response rate from post license renewal survey completion and the eblast survey completions was 10.5%. Data analysis was completed, the draft report was written and shared with the Illinois Nursing Workforce Center (INWC) Advisory Board members during the past few months. Recommended revisions received from the INWC board were incorporated. Motion was made/seconded: B. Miller/D. Sherry move to approve the LPN 2025 draft report.

2. Illinois license renewal 2026 draft nurse surveys:

IDFPR will be required by legislation, HB3487 20ILCS2105-368 to collect demographic information on all licensees effective 1/1/2026. Online license renewal nurse surveys have been conducted by the Illinois Nursing Workforce Center (INWC) since 2014. The revisions are to the LPN, RN, APRN and FPA-APRN surveys that will be distributed during the 2026-27 license renewal process. As mandated by legislation HB1615/PA225 ILCS65/75-10 data will be voluntarily collected during the biennial license renewal process and should include the National Forum of State Nursing Workforce Centers (The Forum) Minimum Supply Data Set (MDS) which was revised December 2024. The surveys for LPN, RN, APRN AND FPA-APRN are in the same format as The Forum MDS. Surveys have the same sections, and the questions are in the same order with limited revisions to questions, answer options and additional questions. The APRN and FPA-APRN surveys had questions deleted from previous surveys that are now part of the license renewal process. These surveys were shared with the Illinois Nursing Workforce Center (INWC) Advisory Board members during the past few months prior to this board meeting.

Discussion: included clarification if RNs and LPNs can be part of a licensure compact — yes. A nurse with a compact license is to have the compact license in his/her home state. Revision in questions included: do you have licenses in multiple states, separate nursing faculty and nursing education questions, clarify student loan question to ask if student loan is for education at any level, add not applicable and/or not working as an answer option to a few questions, clarify telehealth is a billable service, hospital clinical educator is a nurse educator outside academia, self-employment. Survey process — since APRNs and FPA-APRNs must first be licensed as RNs, and since the survey will be offered prior to license renewal, if the APRN or FPA-APRN answers "yes" they are licensed as an APRN or FPA-APRN will they be cut-off and stopped from answering the remainder of the RN survey questions? The goal is that the nurse does not have to complete both surveys that have similar questions. Since the license renewal process begins March 2026, there is an opportunity for limited revision, such as adding a question, to the surveys.

At the May 2025 board meeting INWC BOD meeting there was general agreement to license renewal supply survey questions. The board agreed to these additional revisions that will begin to be included in the new licensing system this month.
